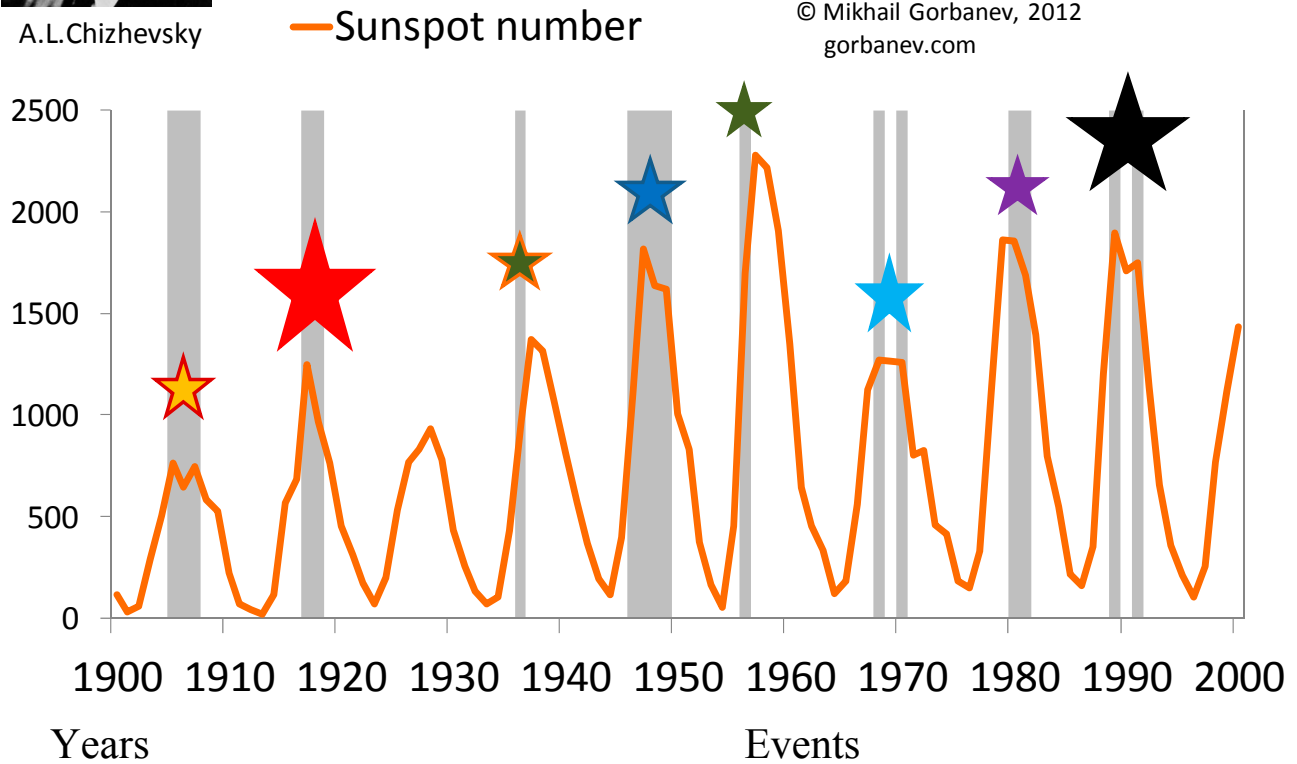

1917 1918	February Revolution, Great October Socialist Revolution in Russia Revolutions in Germany and Hungary, collapse of Austro-Hungarian Empire
1936	Revolution in Spain
1946-49	Conversion of Eastern Europe to socialism
1956	Hungarian Revolution, Poznań protests in Poland
1968 1970	“Prague Spring” in Czechoslovakia Protests in Poland
1980-81	Polish crisis, emergence of “Solidarity”, martial law in Poland
1989 1991	Fall of Berlin Wall, collapse of communism in Eastern Europe Collapse of Soviet Union and Yugoslavia

According to Alexander Chizhevsky, revolutions, riots, protests and mass movements are more frequent around cyclical maximums of solar activity, which can be measured by the number of sunspots on the sun surface
